Things are going great! I've spent the last week doing compressor PM's, and it is so nice to press a couple of buttons and have our compressors respond. We have been able to improve our compressed air efficiency by approx. 25% which is great. Like I said, we had a fault with the omni card, and when I cycled the power, the setpoints went to zero on the centac's until the omni card went on-line, and setpoints reset to normal. So for a few minutes(maybe seconds, which felt like eternity), my setpoints still went to zero. Our biggest challenge from here will be operator error.

By the way, the comm. is disabled on AC2 and AC5 for maintenance.
